E85 can be used by “flex fuel vehicles” or FFV’s, cars, minivans and trucks designed to burn either E85 or traditional gasoline. Nationwide, nearly four million FFV’s are now on the road. The flexible fuel option is standard equipment on many car and truck models produced by Ford, General Motors, DaimlerChrysler, Isuzu, Mercury and Mazda.
